#### **Important Safety Precautions**

# **IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS** - READ CAREFULLY AND KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

Do not immerse the appliance, power supply cord or plug in water or any other liquid to protect against electric shock

If the power supply cord or plug is damaged, the appliance must not be operated until it has been repaired by a competent person

Do not put foreign objects into the appliance. It may cause electric shock or abnormal operations resulting in injury

Only allow children to use the toaster without supervision when adequate instructions have been given so that the child is able to use the toaster in a safe way and understands the hazards of improper use

Do not let the cord touch hot surfaces, be near hot gas or electric burners or be in a heated toaster

Do not use any accessories other than the accompany ones provided within the packaging



Do not use for any other purposes apart from cooking

Do not touch hot surfaces. Always use the knobs and handles

Do not use outdoors

Do not insert any oversized food or metal utensils as they may create a fire or risk of electric shock

Do not store any item on the top of the appliance when in operation

Do not clean with metal scouring pads as it can break off and get in contact with electrical parts thereby creating a risk of electric shock

Do not use containers that are made of materials other than metal or glass

Do not cover any part of the toaster with metal foil as it may cause overheating

Do not store any materials other than the accompany accessories in the appliance when not in use.

#### **General Safety Guidelines**

- 1. To read the instruction manual before using the appliance
- 2. All warnings and cautions on the appliance and in the instruction manual must be followed
- 3. The appliance should not be used near water for example, near a sink, bathtub, swimming pool, etc.
- 4. The appliance should be situated such that its location does not interfere with its ventilation.
- 5. The appliance should be situated away from heat sources such as stoves, radiators or other equipment that produces heat.
- 6. The appliance should be connected to a power supply only of the type that is described in the instruction manual.
- 7. Precautions must be taken to ensure that grounding of the appliance is not compromised.
- 8. Power supply cords should be routed such that they are not likely to be walked on or tangled by items placed upon or against them.
- 9. The appliance should be cleaned as per instructed in the manual
- The power supply cord should be unplugged from the outlet when left unused for a long period of time
- 11. Care should be taken to ensure that foreign objects or liquids are not spilled into the openings of the appliance
- 12. The appliance should be serviced by a competent person when:
  - a. The power supply cord or plug has been damaged
  - b. Foreign objects or liquid have entered into the equipment
  - c. The appliance has been exposed to rain
  - d. The appliance exhibits a marked change in performance
  - e. The appliance has been dropped or damaged
- There should be no attempts to service the equipment beyond that described in the manual. All servicing should be performed by a competent person.









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- Place the bake tray on the bake grill before use. Do not place the bake tray directly on the heating element.
- To clean the crumb tray if it is dirty before use






### **Operating Instructions**

#### Preparation before use

 Place the appliance on a stable and horizontal table with proper clearance distances as shown below



- 2. Insert the crumb tray
- 3. Remove the fasteners from the bake grill




4. Plug the power supply cord into an electrical outlet


When using for the first time, take note of the following

- Remove the accompanying accessories and clean them.
   Thoroughly dry them before re-assembling back into the toaster
- After re-assembling, we recommend that you turn it to the maximum temperature for 15 minutes to eliminate any packing oil
- Ensure that the knobs are in the original position before putting any food in
- The heating element will turn red as the temperature goes up. In order to prevent over-cooking, you may like to stay beside the toaster

#### **Preparing the Water Tank**



- Pull out the water tank, remove the lid and fill it up with water to the maximum line before cooking
- After cooking, pull out the water tank, remove the lid and discard the water and wash the water tank for hygiene purposes. Allow it to dry sufficiently before inserting it back.





- · Do not put more water than the MAX line
- Do not put too little water as if might not be sufficient for the operation of the humidifier function. It is recommended to fill it up to the MAX line every time before use.
- Do not put anything other than water into the water tank as it may cause a malfunction
- Do not move the appliance after adding the water as it may cause a malfunction.

#### How to operate the Auto Cooking Mode

- 1. Press the power button to turn on the power of the appliance
- 2. Turn the knob to select a menu. The temperature and time are configured automatically based on the selection of the menu
- 3. Press the Start/Stop button to activate the cooking
- Once the cooking has completed, an "End" will be displayed on the electronic control panel
- After cooking, take out the cooked food. Be mindful that it will be hot so do consider the use of toaster gloves to prevent any occurrence of burns.

<sup>\*</sup>Allow the toaster to cool down with door opened for at least 10:00 mins between each toasting session

- Press the power button to turn on the power and set the temperature.
   Set the temperature by turning the knob. The temperature can be set from 60°C to 230°C
- 2. Set the cooking time by turning the time setting knob. The time can be set between 1 minute to a maximum of 1 hour
- 3. Turn the convection/humidifier knob to select your preferred manual cooking mode
- 4. Once the cooking has completed, an "End" will be displayed on the electronic control panel
- After cooking, take out the cooked food. Be mindful that it will be hot so do consider the use of toaster gloves to prevent any occurrence of burns.

### **Storage and Care**

#### Cleaning

**IMPORTANT**: Before cleaning any part, be sure that the appliance is off, unplugged and cool. Always dry parts thoroughly before using toaster after cleaning.

- Clean the outside of the appliance with a damp cloth and dry thoroughly. A non-abrasive liquid may be used for stubborn stains. Rinse and dry thoroughly. Do not use metal scouring pads or abrasive cleaners that will scratch the surface.
- 2. Clean the Glass Door with a cloth or sponge dampened with warm water. Dry thoroughly.
- 3. Remove the Bake Grill, Bake Tray & Crumb Tray. Wash in soapy water and dry thoroughly.
- 4. Do not use abrasive cleaners or metal scouring pads to clean the Back Rack, Bake Tray & Crumb Tray. For stubborn stains, clean with a nylon or polyester mesh pad and a mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Rinse and dry thoroughly.

**CAUTION**: Do not use spray-on or other toaster cleaners as they may cause electrical damage.

#### Storage

- 1. Unplug appliance and allow it to cool before storing.
- 2. Do not store it while it is hot or still plugged in.
- 3. Do not wrap the power supply cord tightly around the appliance.
- Do not put any stress on the power supply cord as it may cause damage.

## **Trouble-shooting Guide**

The following situations are normal and are not signs that the appliance is malfunctioning.
